



XML and SQL Adapters Define Reusable Legacy Services

With 70 percent of the business data, logic and processes running on mainframe systems, their value and importance are critical for the success of the enterprise. While new Web and composite applications are built to enhance customer service and streamline business operations, the core IT value in many enterprises remains locked within these legacy systems. Leveraging the huge investments in business knowledge put into these systems and integrating them with new technologies is the key challenge for enterprises today.

Attunity Connect for Mainframe has addressed this issue with an integration middleware product that provides a set of standard adapters to numerous legacy systems on OS/390 and z/OS, as well as on many other platforms. Attunity Connect is built as a real-time, direct integration solution, providing SQL- and XML-based interfaces to mainframe

Attunity Connect manages distributed transactions and supports client-managed transactions.

XML Access to Mainframe Applications

To make legacy functions accessible for enterprise applications, it needs to be provided as a service that can be accessed via some API or protocol that the client application will find easy to consume. Attunity Connect supports Java/J2EE clients, Windows/.NET clients, and Web clients by providing JCA, COM, .NET, and SOAP interfaces. All of these interfaces use XML, the leading standard for application integration, as the interface for the adapter interactions. The advantage of using XML is that it hides the native data types and structures, and exposes the interface as a document that can be processed anywhere.

Leveraging Legacy Metadata to Define Adapters

A major part of legacy integration requires setting up adapters and defining metadata that represents their interfaces. Such information typically exists already in the form of legacy metadata. By leveraging legacy metadata, the integration effort can be minimized and shortened dramatically. Attunity Connect provides comprehensive support for metadata, with tools and utilities to edit, manage and harvest metadata. Legacy metadata can be imported automatically to quickly set up adapters and their schema definitions. Attunity provides metadata-harvesting utilities for all its mainframe adapters.
